To Whom it May Concern:

In January of 1997, I adopted a seven week old chow/husky mix puppy from our local shelter. From the beginning, he was a little on the aggressive side. As he got a little older, he became uncontrollable and aggressive. I looked for a few obedience schools, but either of them were convenient or affordable. I then took my puppy to Total Control Dog Training, received a free demo, and started the program in May. When we began, my puppy was aggressive towards Steve and the other dogs in our class. He has tried to bite our Vet several times and other people who have tried to pet him.

After our first class, my family and I saw a tremendous difference. He began to listen and obey our commands. After three months, he is now easily controllable and not aggressive towards people or other dogs. If it had not been for Total Control Dog Training and the lessons taught, I don't think I would still have my puppy today. Since taking the class, I am now able to walk and play with my puppy, travel with him in the car, but most of all stay in control of him.

I would recommend this program to anyone who has a aggressive or hyper dog. The practices performed are very humane and nonviolent. For many dogs this is their last chance before being put to sleep. If it's worth keeping your dog, this is a class that should be taken.
